This 19th edition of the industry's leading event was an **excellent crop**:

- the event spaces sold out 2 months before its opening,
- visitors showing a significant increase with more decision-makers than ever,
- exhibitors delighted with their participation and numerous orders,
- a trade exhibition that elevates its standards at each edition, featuring magnificent stands,
- the new Funéraire d'Or Competition, recognizing significant innovations,
- captivating conferences which attracted full audiences with high-quality speakers.

FUNERAIRE PARIS 2023 was **exceptional in every respect**. Thanks to the well-organized layout of the exhibition space and stands, the event was notable for a highly significant increase in attendance from both exhibitors and visitors. The industry showed strong mobilization, and satisfaction was unanimous both in the aisles and on the stands.

#### Exhibitors: a comprehensive and representative offer

#### FUNERAIRE PARIS 2023 gathered:

- **217 exhibitors**, representing an increase of 30 companies and a growth of 16% compared to 2021, offering a diversified showcase of the future market,
- 74 new participants, accounting for one-third of the total and a 48% increase compared to the previous edition,
- 36 international companies, representing 17% of all exhibitors and coming from 14 countries (Germany, Austria, Belgium, Canada, China, Spain, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Portugal, United Kingdom and Ukraine).

#### Visitors: an increasing quality visitorship

Exhibitors praised the quality of the visitors, who were exclusively professional and decision-makers. A large majority of visitors are looking for the latest trends and are on the lookout for innovations.

The trade exhibition attracted more than 6,000 professionals, representing a 22% increase in attendance - a level not seen for 20 years.

International visitors accounted for 14% of the total, from 60 countries.

It is worth highlighting the **19% increase in French visitors**, who came from all over the country, including the French overseas departments and territories, with a peak on Thursday.

This is an **incredible performance** that confirms the attractiveness and leading position of the Parisian trade exhibition.
